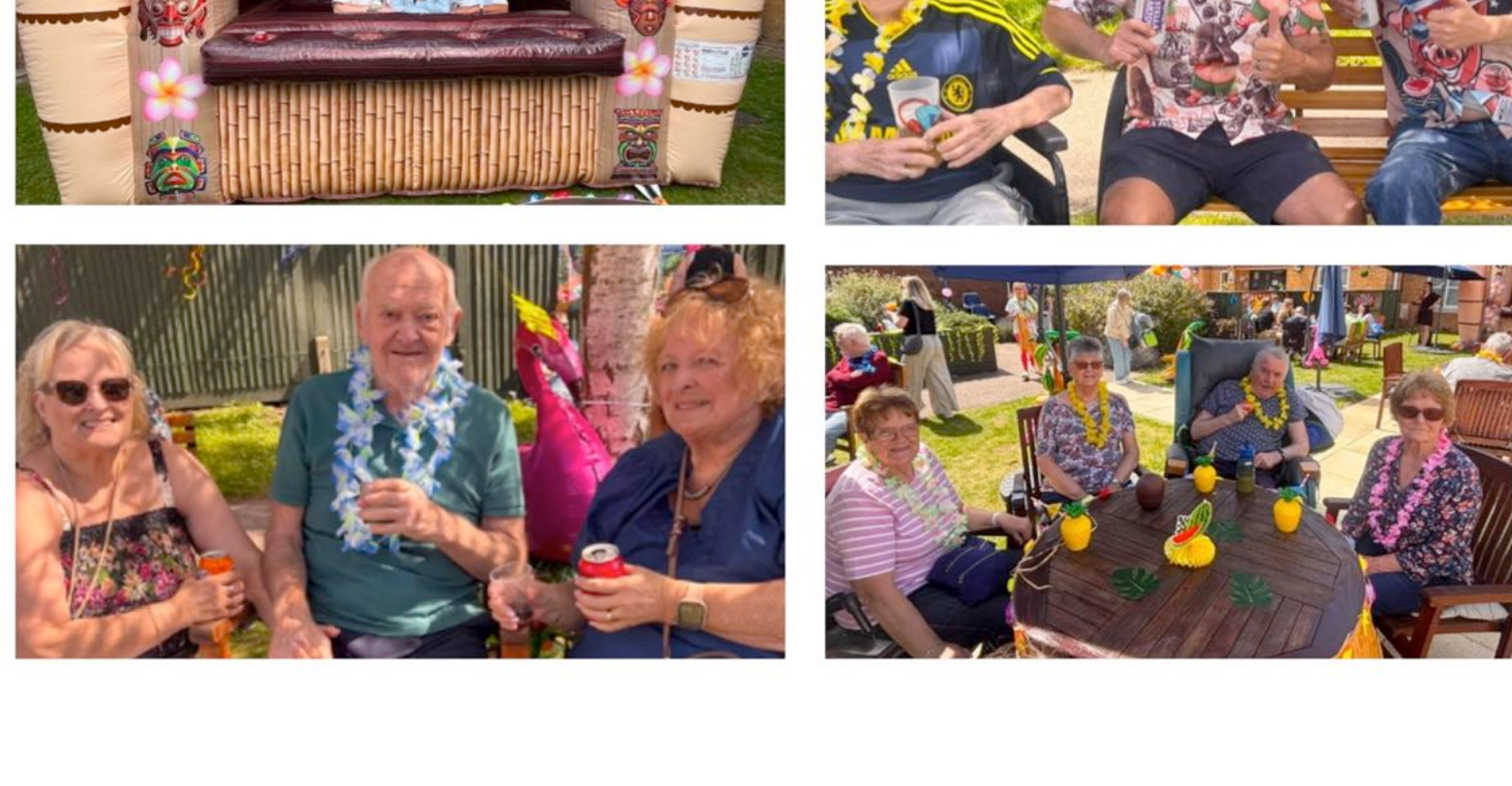
ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

It was a wonderful afternoon that brought everyone together and created plenty of happy memories.

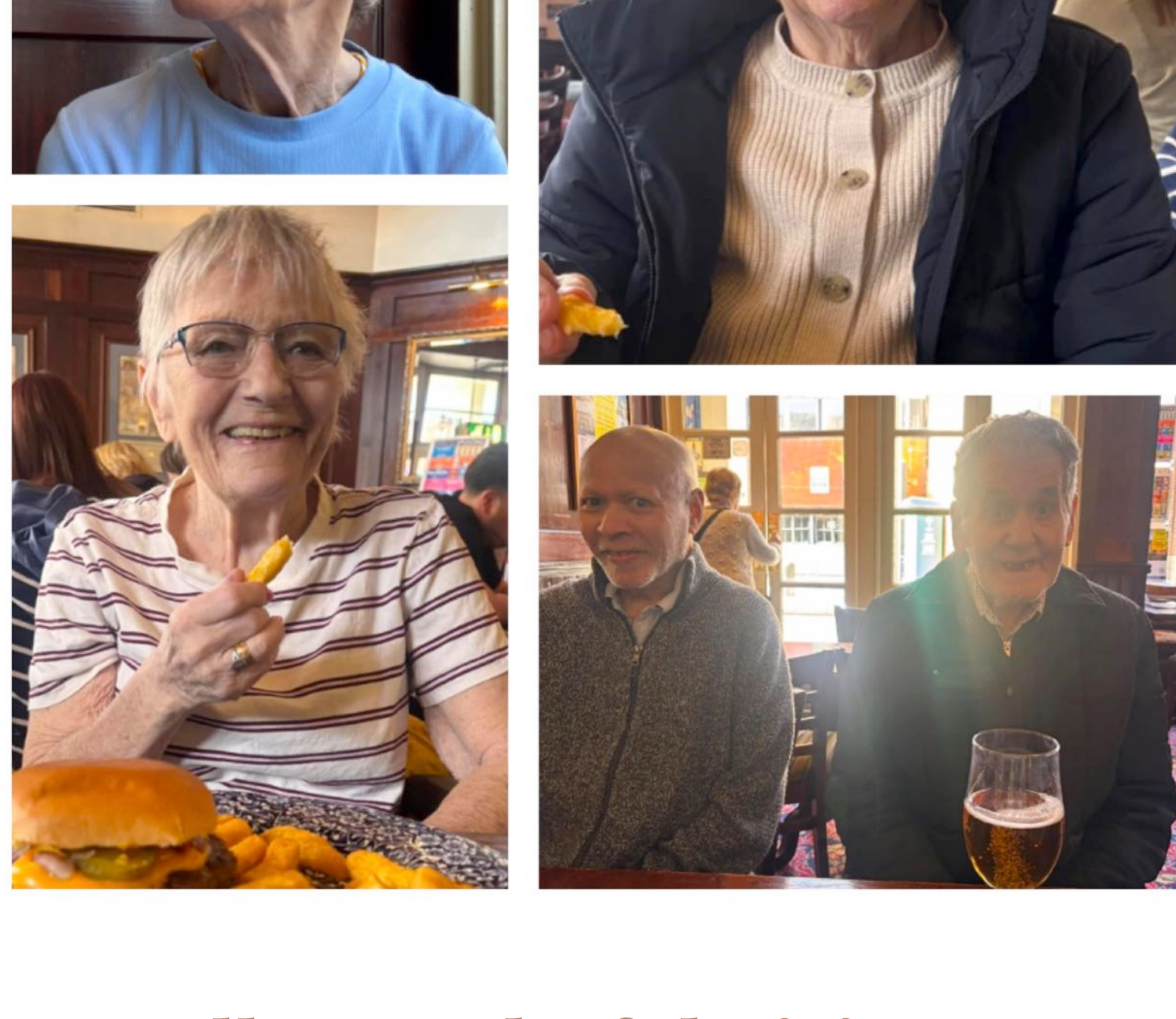


Lunch Out Together

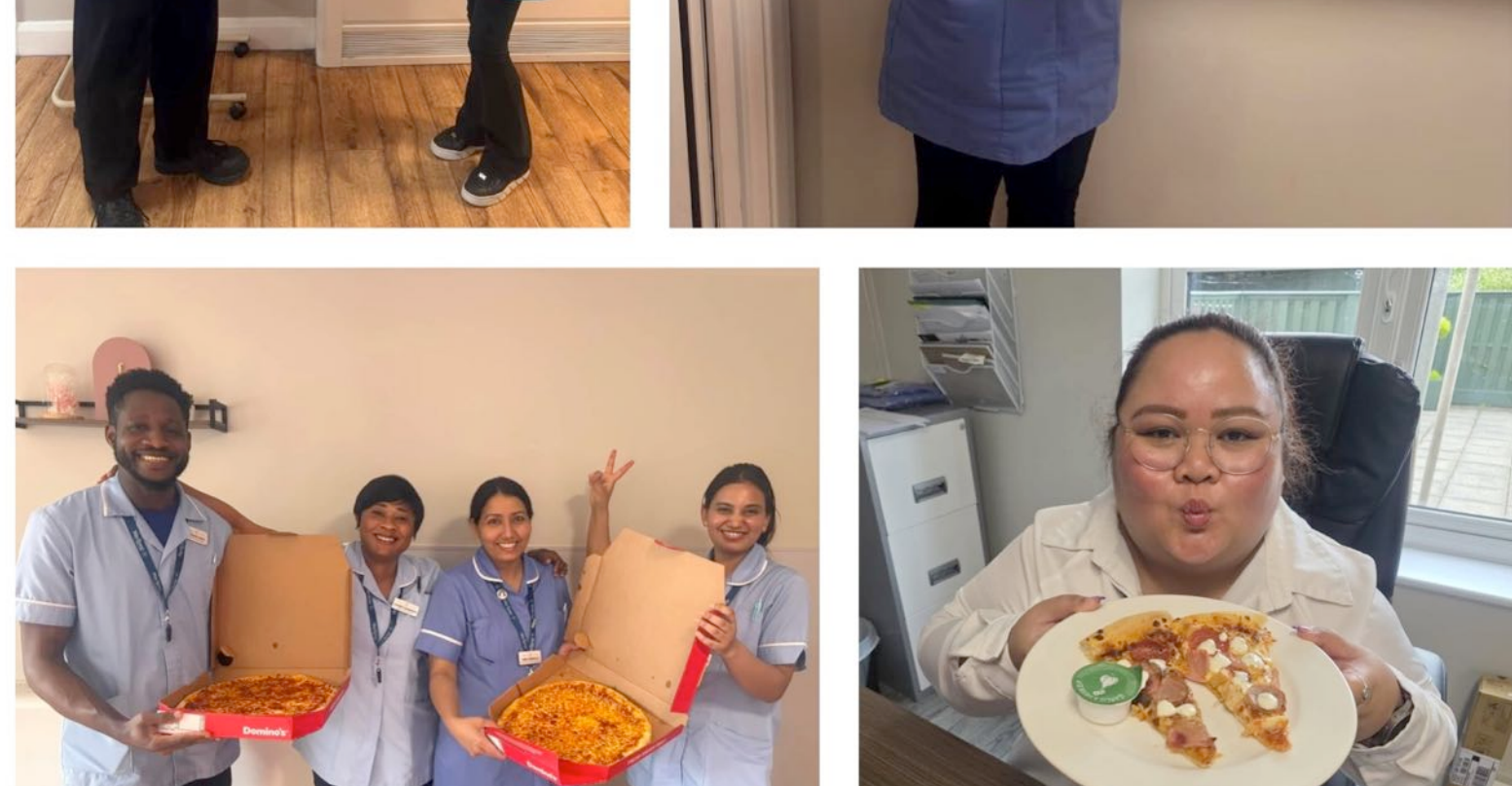


Supporting Mental Health

The day was filled with smiles and laughter, making it another memorable occasion at Mayflower.

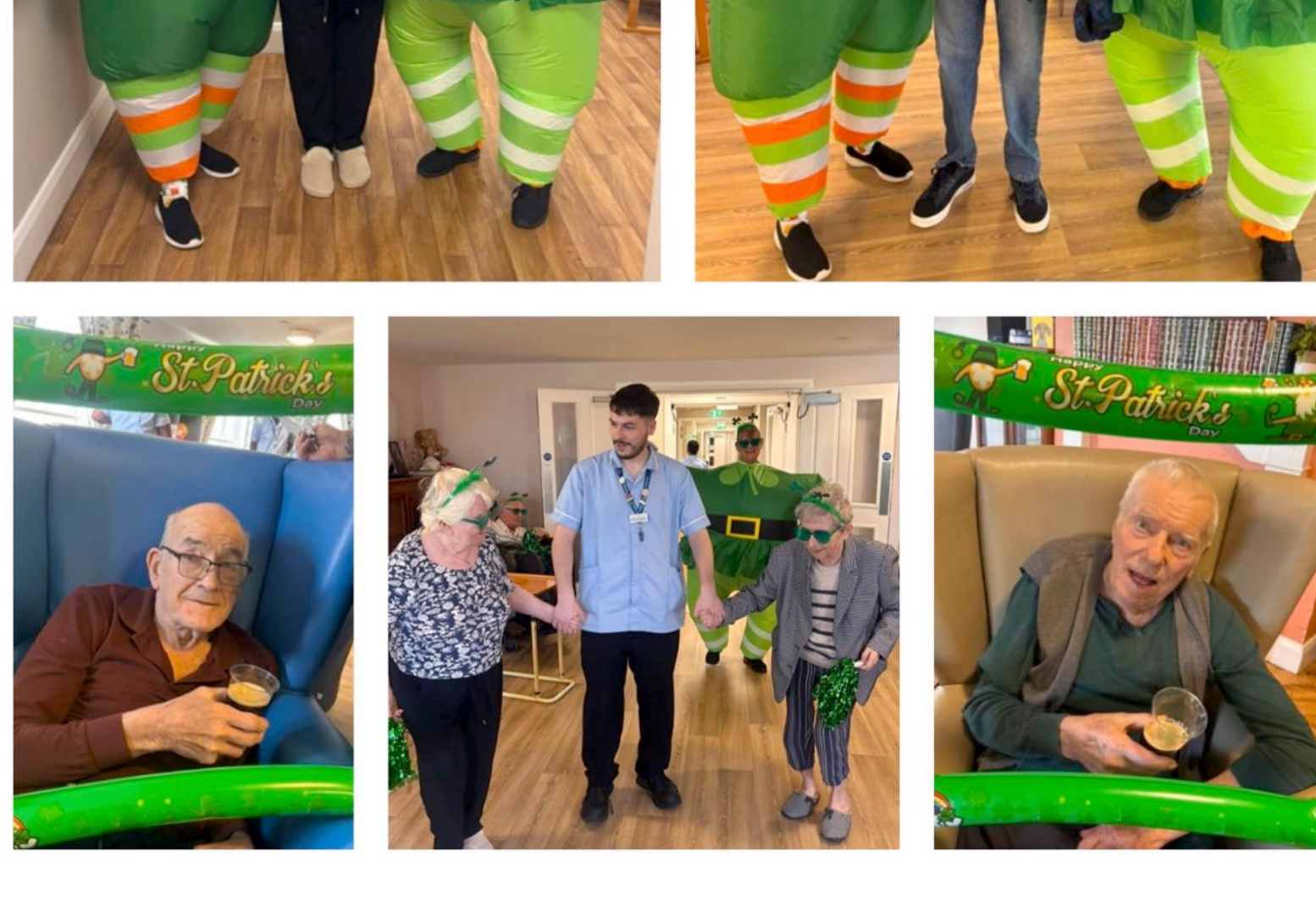


St Patrick's Day Celebrations

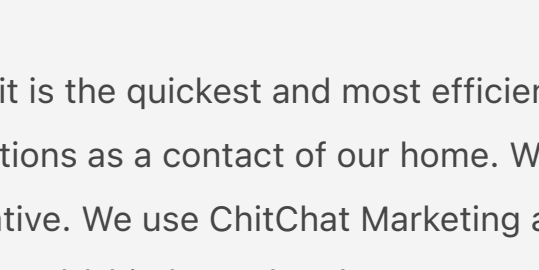

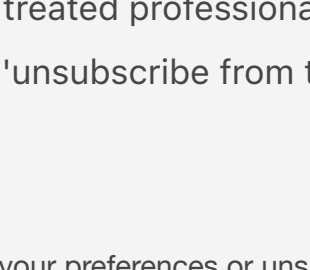
